## The 2nd RACE of the Triple Crown in the Books

WHAT'S UP? MEDIA

The Triple Crown of Charity Sailing was created in 2018 to recognize the top sailor and fundraiser for The Leukemia Cup, The CRAB Cup, and The Hospice Cup races.



Skippers <u>must compete</u> in all three races in order to be eligible to win the Weems & Plath Triple Crown Trophy. The races are as follows:

Annapolis Leukemia Cup Regatta - June 4 The CRAB Cup - August 20 The Hospice Cup - September 17

The calculation for the winner shall be the order of finish in each race and the amount of funds raised for each race.

The skipper with the best score and highest fundraising in the three races is awarded the Triple Crown of Charity Sailing Trophy in October at a public event hosted by the three non-profits at Annapolis Market House downtown.

The trophy will be on display at the Eastport Yacht Club during racing season, and the future Annapolis Adaptive Boating Center in the off-season. The winning skipper and runner-up will receive "keeper" trophies from Weems & Plath.
